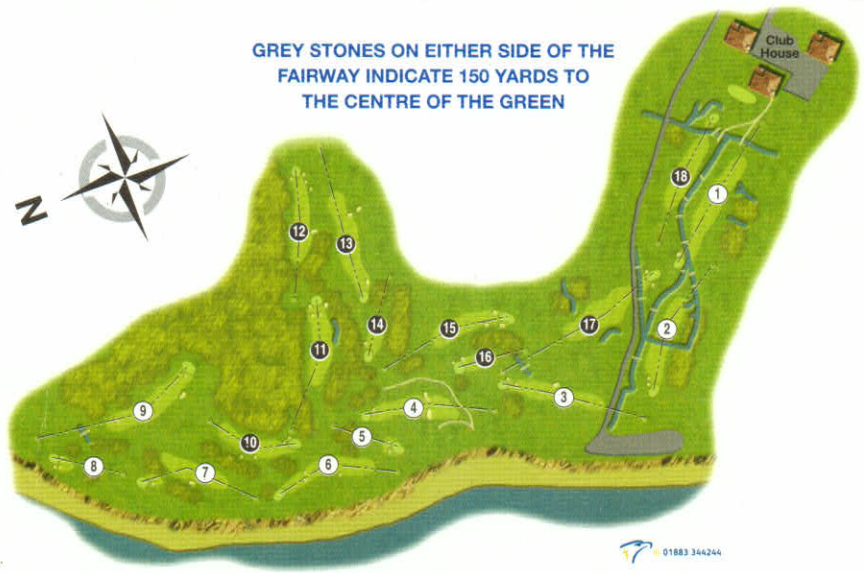

LOCAL RULES

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 18)

- The Starters hut, nets and irrigation lake on the 1st hole.
- On or beyond the road on the right side of the 2nd hole and left of 18th.
- Beyond the white posts and tarmac road to the left of the 3rd hole.
- Beyond the white stones and markers to the left of the 4th hole.
- Beyond any part of the fence on the 5th and 6th holes.

2. PENALTY AREAS (Rule 17)

Defined by yellow and red stakes/lines.

3. ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (Rule 16)

In the general area, areas of damage caused by Animals and their hoofs are treated as ground under repair from which relief is allowed under Rule 16.1b. Free relief is also available from animal dung but only if it interferes with the player's swing.

Timber faced bunkers-Rule 16.1c applies, free relief within the bunker if the timbers interferes with your stance or swing, one stroke penalty line of sight relief outside the bunker.

All tarmac roads, stone and astro turf paths on the course are treated as immovable obstructions from which free relief is allowed under Rule 16.1.

Ground under repair is defined by white paint.

Immovable obstructions are; sprinkler heads, hydrant and drainage lids, white and grey stones, timber sleepers outside the penalty area: In addition to the types of interference described in Rule 16.1a, when a ball lies in the general area, interference also exists if an immovable obstruction is: on the player's line of play, is within two club-lengths of the putting green and is within two club-lengths of the ball. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b. (Exception – There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.)

4. MOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 19)

All tapes and supporting posts surrounding greens. NOTE: If a ball in motion strikes a tape or supporting post no relief is available.

5. AERATION HOLES

Ball lies in or touches an aeration hole identify area, such as the general area, or on the putting green, relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.

6. COMPETITION COURSE

- The Practice Ground on the left side of the 1st hole but it is an area on which competitors may practise on any competition day.
- The entire paddock area excluding the practice chipping green and associated bunkers - short game shots within this area before starting any strokeplay competition are permitted.
- All other forms of practice on the course, or from or, to the paddock are prohibited. Penalty: Disqualification. (Rule 5.2b).

7. INFORMATION

Any additional temporary Local Rules in force will be displayed on the Notice Board in the hall of the Clubhouse.
